SUBJECT: Approve the 5th Amendment with SANSIO to provide Data Collection Services for the Emergency Medical Services Agency through June 30, 2016. All Districts [\$131,370 Total] 100% funded by EMS Fees.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve the 5th Amendment with Sansio for \$10,947 per month not to exceed \$131,370 through June 30, 2016; and,
2. Authorize the Purchasing Agent, in accordance with Ordinance No. 459, to sign amendments that do not change the substantive terms of the Agreement, including amendments to the compensation provision that do not exceed the annual CPI rates, as approved by County Counsel; and,
3. Authorize the Chairperson of the Board to execute and sign two (2) originals of said Amendment on behalf of the County of Riverside.

Summary (continued)

The County requires an Electronic Patient Care Record (ePCR) to be in compliance with the California Code of Regulations, Title 22, §100147(e), which requires that the local Emergency Medical Services (EMS) agency has a system for prehospital data collection to evaluate emergency medical care.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

There is no negative impact on citizens or businesses in the County of Riverside.

SUPPLEMENTAL:

Additional Fiscal Information

Funding for this agreement comes from fees paid by EMS providers. No net county funds will be used.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

Sansio was awarded Prehospital Data Collection on Board Agenda Items 3.13, May 18, 2010 for five years, annually renewable.

Recently, Purchasing released a Request for Proposals #HSARC285, soliciting proposals from 20 companies and advertising on the County's website. Five competitive responses were received for the ePRC system. An evaluation team consisting of representatives from REMSA, a base hospital, and county and city fire departments evaluated the proposals and selected ImageTrend as the lowest cost, most responsive/responsible bidder. The ImageTrend agreement will appear as a separate item on today's agenda. However, to ensure uninterrupted service a transition period is needed. Therefore, the department is requesting an amendment to the SANSIO agreement, on a month to month basis, until the transition can be completed. It is anticipated that the transition period will be completed by January 1, 2016.

Original Contract Term: May 18, 2010 through June 30, 2015

Annual Maximum Contract Amount: \$131,370

The Agreement between Riverside County, herein referred to as COUNTY and SANSIO, herein referred to as CONTRACTOR, is amended as follows:



1. On page 3 of the Agreement, amend Section 2 the "Period of Performance":
To amend all reference to the Period of Performance from expiration of June 30, 2015 to a Period of Performance through June 30, 2016 unless terminated as specified in Section 5 TERMINATION. All other terms of the Period of Performance in the Agreement shall apply.
2. On page 3 of the Agreement, amend Section 3 the "Compensation":
The COUNTY agrees to pay CONTRACTOR for services performed at a monthly rate of Ten Thousand, Nine Hundred and Forty Seven dollars (\$10,947) to be paid in monthly installments including all expenses, based on the availability of fiscal funding.
3. All other terms and conditions of the Agreement are to remain unchanged.


