

1 for the District for May 2, 2023 on the propositions to levy a special tax within the District and to
2 establish an appropriations limit for the District.

3 d. Pursuant to the terms of the Resolution of Formation and the provisions of the Act,
4 said special election was held on May 2, 2023. Each of the propositions was approved by more than two-
5 thirds of the votes cast at said special election.

6 e. Pursuant to the Act, the Board of Supervisors is the *ex officio* legislative body (the
7 “Legislative Body”) of the District.

8 Section 2. PURPOSE. The purpose of this ordinance is to provide for the levy of a special tax
9 within the District.

10 Section 3. AUTHORITY. This ordinance is adopted pursuant to Sections 53328 and 53340 of
11 the California Government Code, which authorizes counties to adopt ordinances to levy special taxes at
12 the rate and in accordance with the method of apportionment specified in the resolution of formation of
13 the community facilities district.

14 Section 4. LEVY OF SPECIAL TAXES.

15 a. By the passage of this Ordinance, the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes and
16 levies special taxes within the District pursuant to Sections 53328 and 53340 of the Government Code, at
17 the rate and in accordance with the method of apportionment (the “Rate and Method”) set forth in the
18 Resolution of Formation and attached as Exhibit A hereto and made a part hereof. The special taxes are
19 hereby levied commencing in the fiscal year 2022-2023 and in each fiscal year thereafter for the period
20 necessary to satisfy the Special Tax Requirement (as defined in the Rate and Method) and until action is
21 taken by the Board of Supervisors, acting as the Legislative Body of the District, to dissolve the District.

22 b. The Board of Supervisors, acting as the Legislative Body of the District, is hereby
23 authorized and directed each fiscal year to determine, or cause to be determined, the specific special tax
24 rate and amount to be levied for the next ensuing fiscal year for each parcel of real property within the
25 District, in the manner and as provided in the Rate and Method.

26 c. All of the collections of the special tax shall be used as provided for in the Act, the
27 Rate and Method and the Resolution of Formation, including, but not limited to, to fund, pay for, and
28 finance authorized administration, inspection, and maintenance of lighting, traffic signal maintenance,

1 drainage, park maintenance, graffiti abatement, and enhanced Sheriff services, and to pay expenses
2 incidental thereto, so long as the special taxes are needed to fund such services; to replenish the reserve
3 fund for the District; to pay the costs of administering the District, and to pay the costs of collecting and
4 administering the special tax.

5 d. The special taxes shall be collected from time to time as necessary to meet the
6 financial obligations of the District on the secured real property tax roll in the same manner as ordinary *ad*
7 *valorem* taxes are collected, or may be collected in such other manner as set forth in the Rate and Method.
8 The special taxes shall have the same lien priority, and shall be subject to the same penalties and the same
9 procedure and sale in cases of delinquency as provided for *ad valorem* taxes. The Board of Supervisors,
10 acting as the Legislative Body of the District, is hereby authorized and directed to take all actions
11 necessary in order to affect the proper billing and collection of the special tax, so that the special tax shall
12 be levied and collected in sufficient amounts and at the times necessary to satisfy the financial obligations
13 of the District in each fiscal year.

14 e. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the Board of Supervisors, acting as the Legislative
15 Body of the District, may collect, or cause to be collected, one or more installments of the special taxes by
16 means of direct billing by the District of the property owners within the District if, in the judgment of the
17 Legislative body, such means of collection will reduce the burden of administering the District or is
18 otherwise appropriate in the circumstances. In such event, the special taxes shall become delinquent if not
19 paid when due as set forth in any such respective billing to the property owners.

20 Section 5. EXEMPTIONS. Properties or entities of the state, federal or other local
21 governments shall be exempt from any levy of the special taxes, to the extent set forth in the Rate and
22 Method. In no event shall the special taxes be levied on any parcel within the District in excess of the
23 maximum tax specified in the Rate and Method.

24 Section 6. SEVERABILITY. If for any reason any portion of this ordinance is found to be
25 invalid, or if the special tax is found inapplicable to any particular parcel within the District, by a
26 court of competent jurisdiction, the balance of this ordinance and the application of the special tax to the
27 remaining parcels within the District shall not be affected.

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1 Section 7. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance relating to the levy and collection of special
2 taxes in the District shall take effect immediately upon its passage in accordance with the provisions of
3 Section 25123(c) of the Government Code. The Chair of the Board of Supervisors shall sign this
4 ordinance, and the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors shall attest to the Chair’s signature and then cause a
5 summary of the same to be published within 15 days after its passage at least once in *The Press-*
6 *Enterprise*, a newspaper of general circulation published and circulated in the area of the District.
