

**ORDINANCE NO. 589
(AS AMENDED THROUGH 589.1)
AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO.
589 ACCEPTING THE REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 13522 OF
THE CALIFORNIA PENAL CODE RELATING TO THE RECRUITMENT
AND TRAINING OF DISTRICT ATTORNEY INVESTIGATORS EMPLOYED
BY THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY OF RIVERSIDE COUNTY AND THE
RECRUITMENT AND TRAINING OF THE CORONER AND DEPUTY CORONERS
EMPLOYED BY THE CORONER OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE.**

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California, Ordains as follows:

Section 1. The County of Riverside declares that it desires to qualify to receive aid from the State of California under the provisions of Section 13510 (as amended by Chapters 710 and 966 of the Statutes of 1981) and Section 13524, Chapter 1 of Title 4, Part 4, of the California Penal Code.

Section 2. Pursuant to Section 13522 of the California Penal Code, the County of Riverside District Attorney and District Attorney Investigators, and the Coroner and Deputy coroners of the County of Riverside will adhere to the standards for recruitment and training established by the California Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST).

Section 3. The County of Riverside District Attorney and the Coroner of the County of Riverside will allow the Commission on POST and its representatives to make such inquiries as deemed appropriate by the Commission to ascertain that the District Attorney Investigators and the Coroner and Deputy Coroners of the County of Riverside will adhere to the standards for recruitment and training established by the California Commission on POST.
