ORDINANCE NO. 770
ORDINANCE SPECIFYING QUALIFICATIONS
FOR OFFICE OF TREASURER-TAX COLLECTOR

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California, do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Purpose

The purpose of this Ordinance is to maintain well qualified individuals in the position of Riverside County Treasurer and Tax Collector.

Section 2. Authority

Pursuant to Government Code Section 27000.6 the Board of Supervisors may enact the provisions of Government Code Sections 27000.7, 27000.8 and 27000.9 prior to the first date of the period for filing declarations of candidacy for the office of County Treasurer, County Tax Collector, or County Treasurer-Tax Collector.

Section 3. Enactment of Government Code Provisions

The Board of Supervisors hereby enacts the provisions of Government Code Sections 27000.7, 27000.8 and 27000.9 as presently enacted or subsequently amended or renumbered.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after its adoption.
